Minimum time horizon

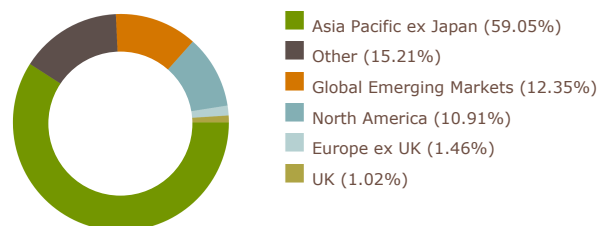

Country allocation



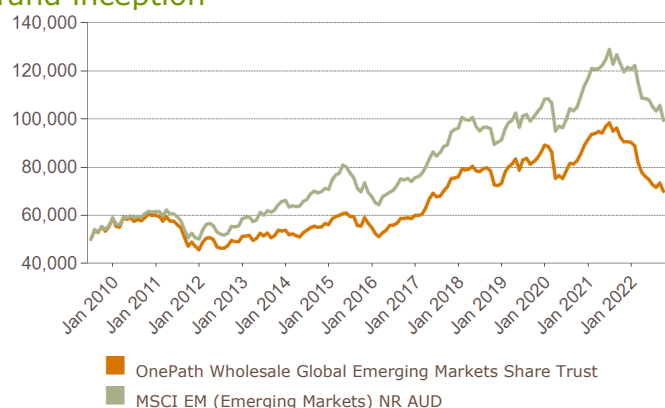

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Market and portfolio review

Global emerging equity markets faced volatility during the quarter. The Fund outperformed the benchmark over the quarter by 1.7% due to a bias towards quality growth managers William Blair and All Spring (Intrinsic).

Market volatility continued in the third quarter of 2022 as investors are focused on the impact of the war on commodity and energy prices, and ultimately higher inflation and rising interest rates. All these issues are stark reminders to investors that events impacting the global economy and financial markets are becoming increasingly difficult to predict. The result will and has been increased volatility and diverging company performance. At such times, the merits of business models that can outperform against difficult backdrops are often underappreciated. Given the volatility of the third quarter, global emerging equity markets returned negative 19.2% for the past year. This was predominantly driven by underperforming China (regulations), as well as the Russian invasion of the Ukraine in February 2022. The Fund underperformed for the year. This was led by managers TT international (China exposure), William Blair (less cyclical exposure) and All Spring (smaller cap orientation).

Future investment strategy

The exposure to high quality companies with sustainable growth in emerging markets should bode well for the medium to longer term. It is anticipated these stocks will continue to perform during both a highly volatile period driven by COVID related issues, as well through to the longer term.
